Discuss the City Water Restriction Action Plan

Executive Summary

The City is currently under Stage 3 water restrictions. The City's water supplier is North Texas Municipal Water District (NTMWD). The NTMWD does not have access to 28% of its water supply from Lake Texoma due to the zebra mussel. Lake Lavon is full since the rains a couple of weeks ago but Lake Jim Chapman remains low. The weather prediction for this summer is for hot, dry weather so the NTMWD plans to at least remain in Stage 3 water restrictions until November. If the current lake level conditions, water usage,

and weather worsen, the NTMWD could implement Stage 4 water restrictions, which does not allow irrigation with sprinklers to landscaping. The City has developed a Water Restriction Action Plan (WRAP) to educate its customers to conserve water. This item will discuss the WRAP and provide an opportunity for the City Council to provide input.
