<u>13-1510</u> Consider acceptance of the Quarterly Budget and Investment Reports for the quarter ended March 31, 2013.

Executive Summary

Cash on hand at 3/31/2013 was \$27,818,062 in all funds; of this amount \$22,818,062 was available for investing. The remaining \$5,000,000 is held in a non-interest bearing analysis account per contract with American National Bank. The average interest/yield on all investments was .28%, and investment earnings totaled \$18,516.

General Fund revenues are at 83% of budget and expenditures are at 51% as of 3/31/2013. Utility Fund revenues are at 43% of budget and expenditures are at 47%. The year-to-date budget status for both funds is typical for this point in the fiscal year.
