Executive Summary

Daycare Simpson-Foster, LLC is constructing Barnyard Gate facility located on the north side of Bunker Hill Road, approximately 625 feet east of State Highway 78. In order to serve the facility with water, the developer is required to construct approximately 575 lineal feet of waterline along the north right-of-way line of To serve the development, an 8 inch waterline is Bunker Hill Road. required; however, Sachse's Capital Improvement Plan includes a 12 inch waterline instead of an 8-inch waterline. This Facilities Agreement would allow for the City's participation in the cost to upsize the waterline from an 8-inch line to a 12-inch line. would upsize costs attributed to the City be offset bν correspondingly reducing the water impact fees charged to the developer.
