Conduct a public hearing and consider an Ordinance of the City of Sachse, Texas, amending the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance and Map, as heretofore amended; to grant a change of zoning from a General Commercial (C-2) district to an Office Park (OP) district on an approximately 12.911 acre tract of land, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and generally located on the northeast corner of President George Bush Turnpike and Miles Road, City of Sachse, Dallas County, Texas; providing for the approval of the Zoning Exhibit attached as Exhibit "B"; providing for the approval of the Site Plan attached as Exhibit "C".

Executive Summary

Consider a resolution of the City Council of the City of Sachse, Texas, awarding the bid for the Sanitary Sewer Improvements to the Merritt Road Lift Station and Sachse Road Lift Station as a capital improvement project to Wilson Contractor Services, LLC; authorizing the City Manager to execute such agreement in a form approved by the City Attorney; and providing an effective date.

Executive Summary

The City of Sachse has a sanitary sewer improvement project for improvements to the Sachse Road Lift Station and the Merritt Road Lift Station. The project is currently funded through RCC Funds as approved in the 2012-2013 CIP in an amount totaling \$1,100,000. The current funding includes \$116,725 for design and \$983,000 for construction. Bids were received for the project on July 25th. The lowest qualified bid for the base project was \$11,395.57 more than the project budget. An Alternate Bid was requested and received for additional equipment to provide backup emergency power and an odor control system. Staff is recommending that the City Council fund the backup emergency power generator and odor control system for improved system performance and reliability.
