Executive Summary

Traffic calming is a community-based initiative, and is not bound by any state or federal requirements or policies. Therefore, each community may determine what guidelines and/or policies are best for their citizens. In a previous discussion with the City Council, staff presented two potential options for a traffic calming process. The Council requested that City staff return with complete additional study on several key items that may be included in the process for Citizens to follow in the request of a traffic calming device. The purpose of this Workshop Item is to discuss in greater detail some specific steps to include in a traffic calming policy for the City of Sachse.
