 - Discuss the TAPS (Texoma Area Paratransit System) program which provides public transportation for Sachse residents.

Executive Summary

City of Sachse residents that are eligible to use the TAPS (Texoma Area Paratransit System) program for rides to and from communities in their service area. Fees are reduced to make TAPS trips more affordable with costs being subsidized by the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) for the fiscal year 2014 period. TAPS took over the transportation program from CCART (Collin County Area Regional Transportation) public transportation system which only served Collin County residents prior to the current fiscal year. The program is funded by federal funds that NCTCOG issues to the program. NCTCOG has access to sufficient funds to fund the program through September 30, 2014. After September 2014, federal funds will continue to partially fund TAPS, and the remainder of the funds will come from cities that use the TAPS service in Collin County. TAPS is here tonight to discuss the possible continuation of this program for Sachse residents. If Sachse continues with TAPS, there will be an annual cost starting in fiscal year 2015 that will depend on several factors including limitations on who can use the service and the number of riders.
