# **Executive Summary**

Cash on hand at 12/31/2014 was \$30,020,459 in all funds; of this amount \$25,020,459 was available for investing. The remaining \$5,000,000 is held in a non-interest bearing analysis account per contract with American National Bank. The average interest/yield on all investments was .29%, and investment earnings totaled \$12,074.

General Fund revenues are at 55% of budget and expenditures are at 24% as of 12/31/2014. Utility Fund revenues are at 26% of budget and expenditures are at 22%. Both funds are at anticipated levels for this period in the fiscal year.

#### **Executive Summary**

It is necessary for the City to maintain licensing for all computer network servers, Exchange, user authentication, firewall-security, workstation operating systems and productivity software that each end-user utilizes on a daily basis. In addition to these licensing requirements, the City has to maintain licensing for anti-spam and anti-virus protection. The Microsoft Enterprise agreement and licensing renewal is proposed for purchase through SHI Government Solutions, which is the City's current Microsoft software vendor. This company is a licensed contract vendor of the State of Texas, Department of Information Services. The term of the renewal agreement will be three years, and will expire in February 2018.

# **Executive Summary**

The widening and paving improvements for Ranch Road from Harlan Drive to Clearmeadow Lane is a Capital Improvement Project for the City of Sachse. The project is funded through an Interlocal Agreement by and between the City of Sachse and Collin County. The widening of Ranch Road from a 2-lane road to a 4-lane road requires additional right-of-way. This item authorizes the use of a title company to close on the five parcels, and also authorizes the purchase of the five parcels of real property needed for the project.

### **Executive Summary**

The City's 2015 Strategic Plan Goal 2--Be a model of financial stewardship through growth management, responsible investment and financial transparency--Strategy 5 includes a task of reviewing opportunities for refunding existing bond debt. The current interest rates are low enough to realize a significant savings to the City by refunding the 2003 Certificates of Obligation, which are currently callable, and a portion of the Series 2009 GO Bonds with the highest coupon rates. The projected savings are \$1.8 million over the remaining life of the bonds, with a present value savings of \$1.3 million.
