<u>15-2923</u> Discuss the P-25 digital radio upgrade and the radio tower.

## **Executive Summary**

Public Safety has been in negotiations with RCC consultants and The City of Garland Radio Division to provide feedback from a request to build a radio equipment tower in the City of Sachse. This tower has been recommended by both Motorola and Harris. The total cost of the P-25 project has reduced from \$2.1 million dollars to \$1.7 million dollars for equipment and the radio tower construction. The City of Garland Radio Division has agreed to pay the cost of the tower if the City of Sachse would donate the land needed for the project reducing the initial cost of the upgrade to \$943,342.
